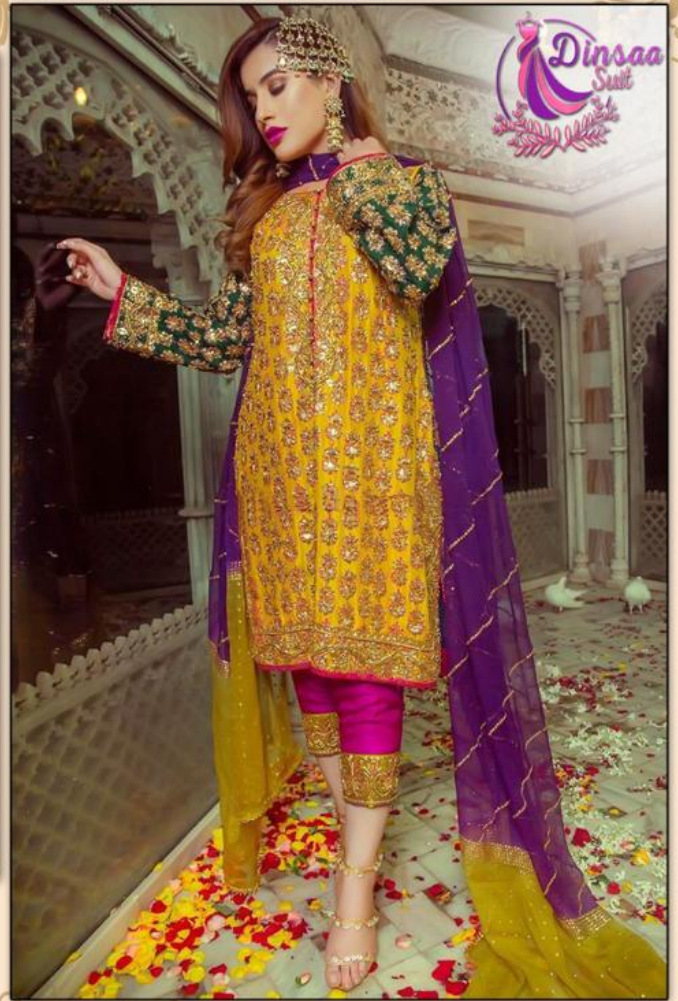
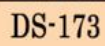


Dupatta- NET EMBROIDERY

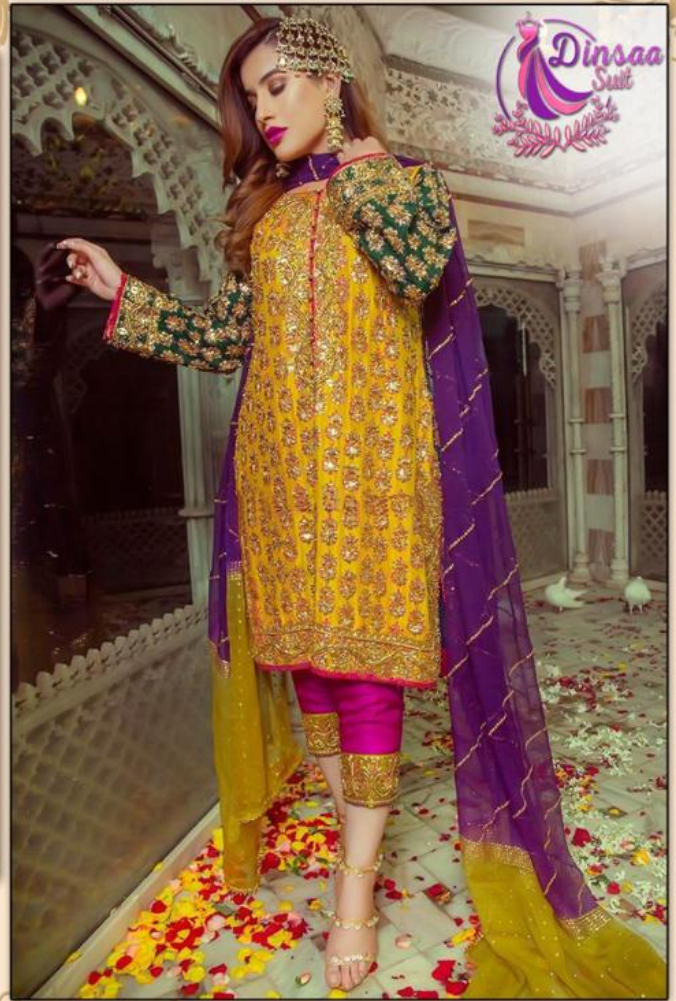
WASHING INSTRUCTIONS
DISINFECTANT AND/OR DISINFECTANT RESIDUES REMAINING ON SURFACES
REPRESENTING SIGNIFICANT RISK SHOULD BE WASHED AWAY IN WATER.
ALL COMPONENTS SPECIFIED FOR DISINFECTANT
DO NOT GET IN CONTACT WITH DISINFECTANT OR DISINFECTANT RESIDUES.
WASH CLOTHES AND WHITE FABRICS SEPARATE
DO NOT USE DISINFECTANT TO WASH DISINFECTANT IN DIRECT SUNLIGHT
(SOME LAUNDRY MARKS AND ACCESSORIES ARE NOT INCLUDED)

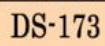
WASHING INSTRUCTIONS
DISINFECT WITH 1% BLEACH OR 70% ISOPROPYL ALCOHOL
BEFORE CUTTING. STAINING MAY BE REMOVED BY SOAKING IN WATER
ALL COMPONENTS SHOULD BE WASHED
DO NOT RE-USE WITHIN 24 HOURS OF FIRST DISINFECTING
WASH CLOTHES AND WHITE GLOVES SEPARATE
DO NOT USE IN CLOSETED OR TIGHTLY SEALED AREAS
DO NOT USE IN HIGHLY HUMID OR VERY DRY AREAS
(DO NOT USE IN HIGHLY HUMID OR VERY DRY AREAS)

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

DISINFECTANT WITH A BLEACH OR CHLORINE-BASED FORMULA
REPAIR CLIPPING, STAINING, MARKS SHOULD BE WASHED IN COLD WATER
ALL COMPONENTS SPECIFIED FOR SINKS
DO NOT USE HOT WATER IN TUBS/TOWELS IN ORDER TO AVOID COPIES
WASH CLOTHS AND WHITE FABRIC SEPARATE
NON-CLIPPING MATERIALS SHOULD BE DISINFECTED IN COLD WATER
(OTHER LAUNDRY INSTRUCTIONS ARE NOT INCLUDED)
